

LISTEN for the answers to these three questions:

What do our neighbors have to teach us?

FOCUS in all that we have heard through the discernment of listening to the Holy Spirit. We will answer these questions:

What are our values?

What is our purpose?

Where are we going?

Who will make it happen?

How will we know when we get there?

LAUNCH is the final phase as we walk with you as you begin to the put the plan into action. We will answer these questions:

What are the first steps to execute?

What needs to stop? What needs to start?

What structure is needed? Then what?
